to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Lilley J. Hyde

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lilley J. Hyde her heirs and assigns forever All my right title and interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina about three miles Southeast from Greenville Court House known and designated as lots numbered 135 and 136 of "Marshall Forest", according to a plat thereof made by Dalton and Neves, dated Oct. 1928, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at pages 133 and 134.
