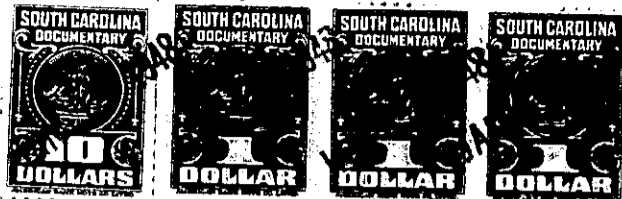

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the North side of Russell Avenue, (sometimes referred to as Elizabeth Street), being known and designated as lot "R", as shown on Plat of North Hills made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1925, which plat was revised in May and September, 1927, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", at Page 89, and having, according to said revised plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Russell Avenue, (sometimes referred to as Elizabeth Street), joint corner of lots "R" and "S" and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 23-30 E. 145 feet to a stake; thence N. 64-00 W. 114 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots Nos. "R" and "Q"; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 3-30 E. 158 feet to an iron pin in the North side of Russell Avenue, (sometimes referred to as Elizabeth Street); thence S. 59-35 E. 45 feet to the beginning corner.
