All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. on the North side of West Earle Street and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of West Earle Street and running thence N. 1-50 E. 180 feet to a stake; thence N. 85-25 W. 43.2 feet to a stake on the line of Lot No. 3; thence S. 7-29 W. 53.4 feet; thence N. 82-31 W. 4.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 1-50 W. 126.6 feet to a stake on the North side of Earle Street; thence S. 85-25 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner; this being known and designated as Lot No. 2 and a portion of Lot No. 3 as shown on a plat of said property in Plat Book F, page 258, office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina.
