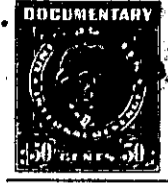

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and re-
leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eugene Bessellieu,
and his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of property of James L.
Love made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, June 9, 1943 and having, according to said
plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of the Old Paris Mountain
Road at corner of Lot No. 1, heretofore conveyed to Otto Evans and Willie P.
Evans, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 72-30 W. 152 feet to an
iron pin on a 12-foot alley; thence with said alley, N. 6-30 W. 55.4 feet to an
iron pin, corner of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N. 74-15 E.
140 feet to an iron pin on Old Paris Mountain Road; thence with the Western side
of said Road, S. 18-45 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

The grantor is to pay 1947 taxes.
