

PARCEL NO. 4:

Also, all those certain parcels or lots of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Paris Mountain Township, in section known as Paris and on and near Highway leading to Spartanburg, S. C., and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 9, 10, 7 and an undesignated parcel lying between said Lots Nos. 9 and 10, on the one side, and Nos. 7 and 8, on the other, on a plat of the J. D. Trammell property recorded in Plat Book "E" at Page 68, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of the said Highway, at corner of a lot designated as Lot No. 8ox on a certain plat recorded in Plat Book F at page 211, which point is approximately one hundred (100) feet East of Mooney Road, and running thence along said Highway in an Easternly direction, 40 feet to a point, corner of an unnamed street; thence along the Western side of said Street to a point on South side of a street running parallel with the P. & N. Railway right-of-way; thence along said last mentioned street in a westerly direction, 20 feet to a point, corner of Lot No. 8 on said Trammell plat; thence along the side line of said Lot No. 8, in a Southernly direction, 50 feet to a point; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 8, in a Westernly direction, 20.3 feet to point on line of property now or formerly owned by Mauldin; thence S. 37-45 E., to a point and then S. 37-11 E. along lines of lots now or formerly owned by Mauldin, Drace and DeMulder, and along line of said lot No. 8ox, to point of beginning on said Highway."
