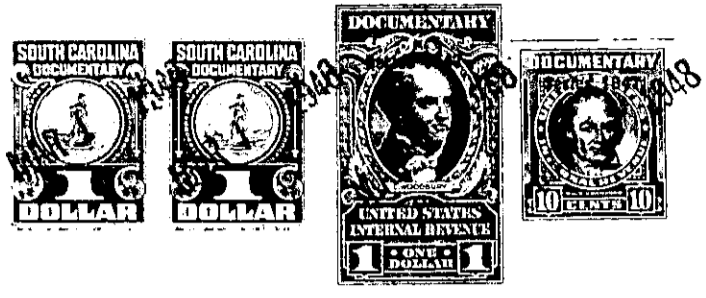

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Tearan C. Gamble and Nancy Gamble,
their

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on north side of Rutherford Road about one mile
from City Limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and design-
ated as Lot Number Two (No. 2) of the E. E. Watson property, on plat
of survey made by G. A. Ellis, July 12, 1945, and, according to said
plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on north side of Rutherford Road at
corner of Lot No. 1 on said plat, same being Fifty (50) feet east of
the intersection of Pine Street with Rutherford Road, and running thence
N. 71-24 E. 50 feet along north side of Rutherford Road to point, cor-
ner of Lot No. 3; thence N. 22-08 W. 140 feet along western line of
Lot No. 3, to iron pin on south side of Emory Street; thence S. 71-24 W.
50 feet along south side of Emory Street, to iron pin, corner of Lot
No. 1; thence S. 22-08 E. 140 feet along eastern line of Lot No. 1, to
the point of beginning on said Rutherford Road; being a part of the
1.94 acre lot of land conveyed to E. E. Watson by W. M. Shelton by deed
dated June 30, 1945, recorded in Vol. 277 at page 228 in R. M. C. of-
fice for said County.
