KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. I. M. Owings, also known as Cleo C. Owings, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Lettie P. Campbell (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Lettie P. Campbell, and her Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Northwest of Berry's Mill, containing 105 acres, more or less, according to survey by Charles E. Rogers, dated Sept. 9, 1903, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an oak, formerly Whilden's corner, and runs thence S. 67 W. 40.80 chains to a stone on branch; thence N. 2 E. 37.75 chains to a stone; formerly Bomar's corner; thence N. 77-1/2 E. 18.40 chains to stone, Kemp's corner; thence S. 35 E. 29.90 chains to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deeds as follows:

Deed of Frank Dill, dated April 12, 1946, to the Grantor herein and S. B. Campbell, recorded in Vol. 290 at Page 437, RMC Office for Greenville County.

Deed of S. B. Campbell to the Grantor herein, dated October 21, 1946, recorded in the RMC Office for said County, said deed conveying to Grantor the one-half undivided interest of S. B. Campbell.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. Lettie P. Campbell, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.
