This contract and agreement made and entered into this 28th. day of August, 1946, by and between W. K. Foster, hereinafter referred to as Party of the First Part, and Mrs. Eunice W. Foster, hereinafter referred to as Party of the Second Part, both residents of the County and State aforesais,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H:

That whereas, the parties hereto are husband and wife, having entered into a marital relationship on the 14th day of January, 1931, in the County of Pickens, State of South Carolina, and lived together thereafter as husband and wife but have concluded that because of certain differences which have arisen between them they have deemed it to their best interest to live separate and apart from each other and, whereas, the parties hereto realizing it is to their best interest, happiness and welfare to live separate and apart, they have, in consideration of the covenants herein contained, entered into and do hereby enter into this Separation Agreement and bind themselves by the terms and conditions of the same.

It is agreed by and between the Parties hereto that they shall live separate and apart from each other as though no marital relationship was ever entered into between them and agree and bind themselves not to molest or interfere with the social, business or financial affairs of each other in anyway. It is further understood and made a part of this agreement that the Party of the First Part hereby releases the Party of the Second Part from any and all obligations and duties of a wife, and hereby releases any and all interest that he may have in and to any and all property now owned by Party of the Second Part, and in and to all property that she may hereafter acquire.
