Plat of Perry property in Section known as Sans Souci, and shown on
Plat recorded in Plat Book I, page 33, R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, and being more particularly described, according to plat by
Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated September 19, 1944, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of
Rogers Street, joint front corners of Lots Nos. 17
and 18; thence with said Avenue N. 79 E. 50 feet to
an iron pin; thence with line of Lots Nos. 18 and 19,
N. 11 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79 W. 50
feet to iron pin; thence with line of Lots Nos. 17 and
18, S. 11 E. 150 feet to the beginning.
