Thomas, William T. Tucker and wife, Ora Lillie Tucker, of Taylors, South Carolina, R.F.D. No. 1, Greenville County and O'Neal Township, were legally married on or about the 24th. day of December, 1925 and have lived together as man and wife since their marriage and have three children by this union, namely, two married daughters, Mrs. Evelyn Sims and Mrs. Ruby Williams, ages, 19 and 17 years respectively, and one son, Grady William Tucker, age 3 years, and whereas,

Both husband and wife are in, and have been for some, time, a state of turmoil, disagreement and incompatibility and desire to permanently separate and live apart, Now, the husband and wife, hereby enter into the following separation agreement:

Both Husband and Wife are to live separate and apart the remainder of their natural lives and neither is to go about or molest the other in any way whatsoever. Each party is to live separate lives just like they had never lived together as man and wife.

The Wife is to and is hereby given full custody of and control over said Son, Grady William Tucker, age 3 years, and she hereby assumes full responsibility for the entire support, education and maintenance of said Son, and the husband is hereby released from any and all support of said Son at all times in the future.

The Wife hereby releases the husband from all future support and maintenance of herself and accepts property and money payment in lieu of any and all rights to dower in any lands husband acquires in the future and hereby agrees to sign Renunciation of Dower to any and all deeds at any time she is requested to do so by husband, said consideration being as follows: The sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars in cash money now being turned over to wife and the title to one 1936 Model Chevrolet Sedan automobile Motor No. 6737820 is hereby made to wife by husband as well as title to one milch
