Cheros, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto George E. Cheros, his heirs and assigns, forever:

(1) All of our undivided one-third interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Augusta Street in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot. No. 5 on plat of W. A. Bates and George Brownlee made by W. D. Neves on January 26, 1913, and being more particularly described as follows:
