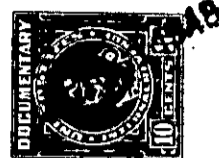

 presents by Rev. R. B. Vaughn \_\_\_\_\_

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released,  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rev. R. B. Vaughn,  
his heirs and assigns forever:\_\_\_\_\_

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina, near the western limits of the City of Greer,  
 on the east side of Franklin Street Extension, at the corner of prop-  
 erty now or formerly belonging to the estate of J. O. Hightower, and  
 runs thence along said Franklin Street Extension in a northerly di-  
 rection sixty and one-fourth (60 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) feet, more or less, to a stake on  
 the eastern side of said Franklin Street Extension at the corner of  
 property now owned by R. B. Vaughn; thence in an easterly direction  
 along the R. B. Vaughn property line to a stake at the corner of the  
 W. M. Miller property; thence in a southerly direction along the said  
 Miller line sixty and one-fourth (60 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) feet, more or less, to a stake  
 at the corner of Miller property and property now or formerly belong-  
 ing to J. O. Hightower Estate; thence in a westerly direction along the  
 boundary of the J. O. Hightower Estate to the beginning corner; and  
 being a part of the same conveyed to J. O. Hightower by deed of I. M.  
 Wood, July 24th, 1923, recorded in Vol. 292 page 364, and devised to  
 Hattie Cox Hightower by the Will of said J. O. Hightower.
