Mrs. S. M. Sullivan, her heirs and assigns: All of our undivided interest in and to:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two and one-half (2½) miles from the City of Greenville in the section known as Free Town and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake 3x James Goodlett's corner Ella Jackson's line and running thence S. 86½ E. 25 feet with said Jackson line to a stake 3x; thence N. 3½ E. 17-3/4 feet to an iron pin 3x on Newton Garrison's line; thence with said line N. 86½ W. 29-3/4 feet to an iron pin James Goodlett's line; thence with Goodlett's line, S. 13½ E. 17-3/4 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property inherited by us from Mrs. L. C. E. Bush who died intestate in Greenville County, S. C., September 27, 1947, and is our undivided interest in the same property conveyed to Mrs. L. C. E. AND ALSO all our right, title and interest, in and to: all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being about two and one-half (2½) miles from the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the section known as Free Town and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on a ten foot alley, thence N. 86-3/4 W. 142 feet to an iron pin on Vicky Scott's line; thence S. 14 W. 28-2/7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82-1/4 E. 144 feet to an iron pin on said alley; thence N. 14 E. 30 feet to the beginning corner.
