of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 of a subdivision known as North Sunset Hills, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at page 92, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Paris Mountain Road at the corner of Lot No. 17, and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 17, N. 26-30 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said Lot No. 17 on the southeast side of an alley; thence along the line of said alley, N. 74-57 E. 57.4 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Elizabeth Drive; thence along the line of said Elizabeth Drive, S. 27-33 E. 135 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of the intersection of Elizabeth Drive with Paris Mountain Road, S. 18-42 W. 34.3 feet to an iron pin on Paris Mountain Road; thence along the line of said Paris Mountain Road, S. 64-57 W. 35.2 feet to the beginning corner.
