(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. Clarence M. Kidd, his Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northwest side of Walnut Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 69 on Plat No. 2 of Overbrook Land Company property, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, April 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "H", Pages 258 and 259 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
