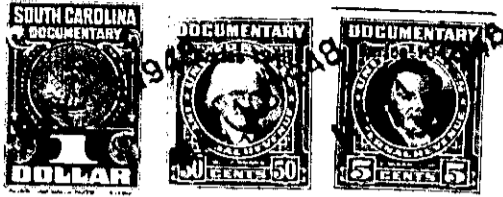

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicksprings Township,

County, State of South Carolina in the town of Taylor, on the south side  
of the National Highway, and known as lot number 11 in the sub-  
division of the C. E. Shockley property as divided by the Interstate  
Land Auction Company on November 3, 1922 and having the following  
metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the said National Highway, joint corner  
of lots 11 and 12, and running thence along the said highway in an  
easterly direction 50 feet to a stake at the joint corner of lots  
10 and 11; thence at right angle in a southerly direction 231  
feet to a joint corner of Said lots 10 and 11 at the edge of the
