H. Woodward, R. E., Dec. 1945 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P" at page 1, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on north side of Eastview Drive, at the front corner of Lot No. 19 on said plat, and running thence N. 18-04 W. 273.2 feet along the line of said Lot No. 19, to point; thence N. 68-18 E. 119.1 feet to point; thence S. 12-00 E. 278.1 feet to point on north side of Eastview Drive; thence S. 71-56 W. 89.0 feet along the north side of Eastview Drive, to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to me by Palmer Dewey Berryhill and Hazel M. Berryhill by deed dated Dec. 31, 1946, recorded in Vol. 304, page 402 in said R. M. C. office.

And this conveyance is made, subject to a right of way reserved for sidewalk and power line.

This property is conveyed, also, subject to following restrictions:

(1) That any residence erected on above property shall face Eastview Drivet

(2) That no residence shall be erected on said property costing less than Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars, exclusive of lot;

(3) That no building shall be erected on said property nearerthan Fifty Five (55) feet to the north side of Eastview Drive;

(4) No surface closet shall be placed or used on said property; (5) That said property shall be used for residential purposes

only and not for any commercial purposes;

(6) That no part of said property shall be sold or rented to, or otherwise disposed of to, any person or persons of African descent.

This property is conveyed subject to an easement and right-of-way across the rear of said lot of land, Ten (10) feet in width at all points, which is expressly reserved by Grantor for the purposes of an alleyway extending eastward from the Augusta Road, if said alleyway is constructed and established before the year 1952.
