This Power of Attorney gives to A. E. Bellume the power to handle her bank account, write checks for her expenses, also to act as her guardian in the event of the death of A. A. Odom, and also to act as joint trustee, with Arthur Mackey, to carry out the last will and testament of the said Susan Bramlett, with full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever, requisite and necessary to be done, as fully to all interests and purposes as I might or could do if present at the doing thereof, hereby ratifying and confirming all things my attorney or his substitute shall do or cause to be done by virtue thereof, in handling the estate of Susan Bramlett.
