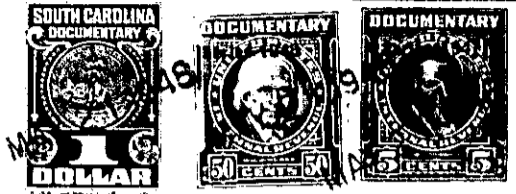

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said F. D. Bryant, and Margaret Bryant.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located on the Eastern side of Blythewood Drive, and
known and designated as Lot # 90 on Map # 2 of Camilla Park, a plat of which is
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "M" at page
85, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses
and distances to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Blythewood Drive, which
iron pin is 340 feet from the Northeastern intersection of Blythewood Drive
and Welcome Avenue, Joint corner of Lots #89 and 90; and running thence with the
joint line of said lots N. 69-24 E., 223.9 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner
of said lots; thence N. 6-42 W., 82.4 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of
Lots #90 and 91; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 69-24 W., 243.2 feet
to an iron pin in the line of Blythewood Drive; thence along the Eastern side of
Blythewood Drive S.20-36 E., 80 feet to the point of beginning.

THE ABOVE LOT IS SUBJECT to the building restrictions set out in the Deed
from the First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, as Administrator and
Trustee to R. A. Johnson, dated March 4, 1946 to be recorded.
