All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, known and designated as lots #6 and #7 of Camilla Park Sub-division as shown by map #2 of same made by W. J. Riddle, December 1943, recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book M, page 85, and according to said plat, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Easley Bridge Road, corner of lot #8 shown on said plat and running thence along the south side of said road, N. 29-09 E. 70.4 feet to bend in said road; thence still along said road N. 33-39 E. 120 feet to iron pin, corner of lot #5 shown on said plat; thence along line of lot #5 S. 56-51 E. 189.4 feet to iron pin at rear joint corner of lots #5 and #6; thence along rear line of lots #62 and 61, S. 37-15 W. 118 feet to iron pin; thence along rear line of lot #61 S. 24-30 W. 59.8 feet to iron pin at rear joint corner of lots #7 and #8; thence along line of lot #8 N. 60-51 W. 186.9 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
