County, State of South Carolina, located just off the Old Spartanburg Road and on an  
unnamed 25 ft. street, just outside the city limits of Greenville, S. C., being  
Lots Nos. 10 and 11, according to plat made by R. E. Dalton, December, 1940,  
being part of the property formerly belonging to W. E. McCain, said plat being
