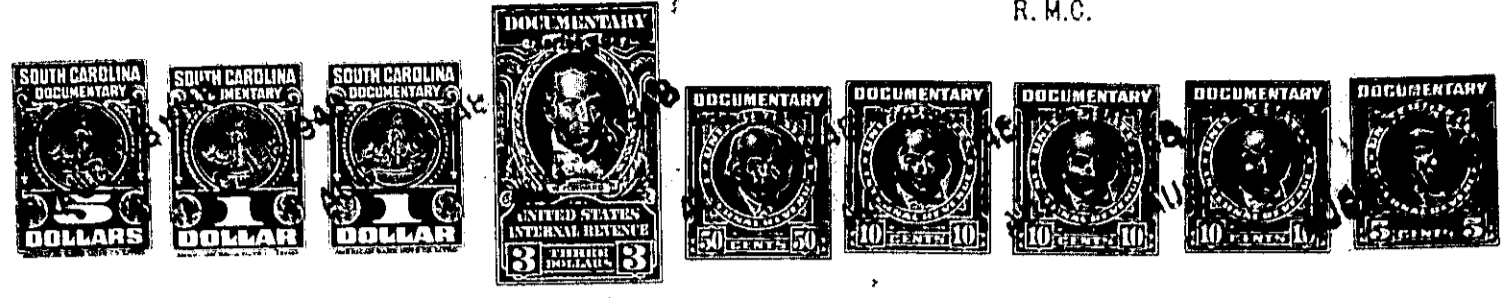

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, D. A. Harvey, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and
00/100 (\$3250.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by J. C. Lawson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. C. Lawson, his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. one hundred and
twenty-one (121) of Conestee, as shown by a plat thereof, made by R. E. Dalton,
Engineer, December, 1943, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, South Carolina, in plat Book "K", at page 276, said lot having the
courses, distances, metes and bounds as are shown on said plat.

This deed is made subject to the easements, reservations
and limitations that are set forth in the deed of the Grantors herein, to
Blackinton Mills, Inc., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,
S. C., in book of Deeds 286, at page 295.

The above described land is identically the same conveyed to me by
W. M. Shelton & Henry P. Willimon on the 23rd day of
