KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, Joe R. Revis and Ida C. Revis in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of SIX HUNDRED FIFTY and No/100 (\$650.00) Dollars to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Harrison Revis (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harrison Revis, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of the Puncombe Road about three miles North of Travelers Rest, South Carolina, and having according to a Plat made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, October 15, 1947, the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of the right-of-way of the Puncombe Road at the Southwest corner of the Wagner property, and running thence with the Wagner line, S. 70-20 E., 277 feet to a stake; thence S. 10-20 W., 212 feet to a nail and cap in center of County road, Northeast corner of the Smith property; thence with the Smith line, N. 70-20 W., 600 feet to a stake on the Eastern edge of right-of-way of Puncombe Road; thence with said right-of-way line, which is 20 feet East of center of road, N. 21 W., 207 feet to the County road. Containing four (4) acres, more or less.
