Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Mildred J. Freeman Clark

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty and No/100 ----- Dollars
to me paid by Mamie E. Parris

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and re-
leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mamie E. Parris

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of property
of G. W. Freeman, made by W. J. Riddle, July 1948 and recorded in the
RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book _____, at page _____
and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3 and
running thence along the joint line of Lots 2 and 1, South 24-30 East
114.5 feet to the line of Jack Thacker; running thence along Jack
Thacker's line South 31-0 West 890 feet to a stake at creek; running
thence along Creek South 50-15 East 137 feet to a stake; running thence
South 07-10 East 114.5 feet to a stake; running thence North 39-0 East
33 1/2 feet, said line being the dividing line between Lots 2 and 3, to an
iron pin in line of Lot No. 1 and being the front corner of Lots 2 and
3, the beginning corner and containing 3.60 acres.

It is expressly understood and agreed that Mamie E. Parris and T.H.
Henderson are to have the right of ingress and egress from the Cedar Lane
Road or Parr's Bridge Road to their lots, and the said Mamie E. Parris is
to have the right of egress and ingress over the land known as Lot No. 3.
It being agreed that a road leading from Lots 2 and 3 over Lot No. 1 is
expressly agreed upon and made a part of the consideration of this Deed by
and between the Grantor and Grantee.
