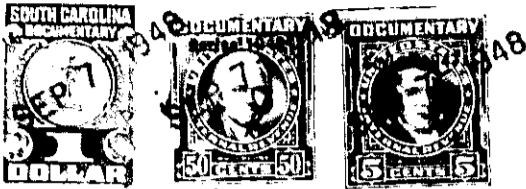

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. H. Mayfield and Frances A.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, located on the North side of College Street  
in the Town of Simpsonville, and being shown as lot # 2 on a plat  
of survey of lands belonging to H. M. Abbott made by W. J. Riddle,  
Surveyor in March 1918, adjoining lands of Horace Goodin and other  
lands of Grantor, and more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of College and corner of  
land owned by Horace Goodin and running thence along line of lot  
# 1 S. 55-00 W. 100 ft. to iron pin; thence N. 65-00 E. 27 ft. to iron  
pin corner of lot # 3; thence along line of lot # 3 S. 24-33 E.  
27 ft. to iron pin on North side of College Street; thence along  
College Street S. 65-00 W. 27 ft. to the beginning corner.
