1. RULES GOVERNING CEMETERY LOT OWNERSHIP. Lots purchased in Graceland Cemetery are conveyed by Warranty Deed to the purchaser to his family and heirs, as a burial place forever.

In order that the Corporation may have a correct record of ownership of all lots where a re-saile and conveyance is made, it is required that the recorded deed shall be presented at its office so that a record of the transfer can be made. A fee of \$2.00 will be collected before any transfer of ownership is made on the Corporation's records. The Corporation is governed by its own records as to ownership of lots.

Where a lot is purchased and an extension of time is granted by the Corporation for payment, the Corporation retains ownership of the lot until all charges due it are paid, and the Corporation reserves the right to remove the remains, which may be intered on the lot, to a smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the original, or to a single grave in the event that a default occurs in the agreed payment.

3. RULES FOR VISITORS AT THE CEMETERY. The cemetery will

be open from seven o'clock a. m., to sunset.

No firearms, refreshments, or intoxicating liquors, shall at any time be brought upon any lot or in any portion of the cemetery; provided, however, that firearms may be used and discharged in case of a military funeral or on a regular appointed Memorial Day or other patriotic service.

No bird or animal shall be killed, wounded, or trapped upon, nor shall any animal or the eggs of any bird be removed from any lot or from any road, walk, park, or parkway, except by the Corporation. DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

The roadways, and walks which are the property of the Corporation are to be used as means of ingress and egress in and to the lots; and visitors and lot owners are to use no other means of ingress or egress.

All persons visiting any lot shall respect the solemnity of the cemetery and no loud noises or disorderly conduct shall be permitted upon any road, walk, park, parkway, or any portion of the cemetery.

A visitor shall touch nothing in the cemetery that does not belong to

Visitors to Graceland Cemetery, who are not members of a funeral pro-ces ion, are requested not to intrude upon a funeral or to loiter about an

open grave. rigiases. Futrance to and exit from the cometery by vehicle or otherwise shall be Gay of the regular established entrance place.

Vehicles shall not pass a funeral procession; nor shall the funeral be dy followed or joined by persons who are strangers. It is not an occasion for idle curiosity.

Vehicles are not to turn around upon any of the roads, but should follow one of the circular driveways to their objective. They shall keep to the right, and when they stop shall be at least six inches from the lawn.

4. RULES GOVERNING MONUMENTS AND FOUNDATIONS. Vaults shall be built only in that part of the cemetery designated for same by the Corporation, and only upon receiving permission from the duly authorized officers of the Corporation. The said wants mur the formible with shelves having divisions allowing interments to be separately reade and perpetually scaled, and alt monuments and all parts of vaults above ground shall be of marble, granite, or other cut stone.

All foundations for monoments are to be laid by the cemetery authoraties at a price to be set by it, and all work in the laying of the fit idation shall be done by the employees of the Corporation, and under the employees of the Superintendent, and completed as rapidly as possible. No foundation shall be laid until the cost of same has been paid for in cach.

No individual marker or headstone shall be placed above ground level, except when permission is granted by the Corporation, and then only in the except when permission is granted by the Corporation, and then only in the except when permission is granted setting markers.

All monoments placed in restricted sections of the cemetry shall conform to the following dimensi as: Four and six grave lots—minimum bases ize 18" × 60", maximum bases ize 18" × 60", mainimum height including base 32". Eight and ten grave lots—minimum bee size 16" x 60", maximum base size 20" x 84", manimum height including base 32". Section 3 and the Northern sub-section of Section 5 are restricted sections. Also other sections which are developed may be declared restricted.

Stone slabs will not be permitted, either erect, or reclining. All stone

Stone slabs will not be permitted, either creet, or reclining. All stone and marble work, monuments and headstones must be accepted by the Superintendent as being in conformity with the foregoing rules before being taken into the cemetery. No material of any kind will be received at the cemetery on Saturday after 12 o'clock noon. When monuments, he adstones, etc., are placed upon any lot sold, no removal of same will be permitted to be made under claim that they are not paid for, or other pretense, without the authority of the officials of the Corporation.

No monument is to be placed until the lot has been fully paid for and after an exact diagram has been submitted to the office of the Corpora-

Individual markers will be placed at each end of the lot and family memorials will be placed in the space provided therefor as shown on detail plat of the cemetery lots.

No family memorial can be erected unless the lot owner has monument privileges.

No mounds will be allowed in the cemetery.

5. PERPETUAL CARE. This Corporation agrees to set aside in a trust fund the last ten (10) percent paid on the purchase price of all lots purchased after November 1, 1947. This trust fund will be used by the Corporation to provide annual care hereafter of lawns, flowers, shrubs, trees and to keep straight and plumb all headstones, curbing and other stone work. The Corporation is not responsible for the wear or damage to monuments, headstones, curbing, or other stone work by the elements, and will not repair or replace same. The extent of the obligation of the Corporation for such annual care is limited to the funds available from such trust fund

Graceland Cometery will take reasonable precaution to protect property of lot or grave owners, properly in the cemetery from loss or damage, but distinctly disclaims all responsibility for loss or damage whether direct or coll, trid, from the acts of thieses, vandals, rioters and malicious mischief makers, from all acts of Providence including especially winds, tornidoes, cyclones, hall, show, frost, fire, explosion or lightning, and from all causes beyond its control.
