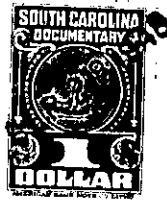

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Robt. B. (Skeet) Hallman and Serena S. Hallman in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and seventy-five (\$175.00) and 00/100 Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Ruth D. Goodman Jannino (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ruth D. Goodman / Jannino her heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 132-U of Springwood Cemetery, having the following dimensions to-wit: North 10.1 feet, East 8.7 feet, South 10 feet and West 7.7 feet, for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of the City of Greenville, S.C., and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said Cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

The above described land is the same conveyed to us by The City of Greenville, S.C. on the 17th day of October 1946, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for County, in Book Page

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Ruth D. Goodman Jannino her Heirs and Assigns forever, subject, however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.
