in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Steel Heddle Manufacturing Company, its successors and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the Southwest side of Paris School Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 as shown on plat of property of Gladys G. Hack, made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book R at Page 1, and having the same number on plat of property of Steel Heddle Manufacturing Co., made by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated October 15, 1948, and having, according to the last mentioned plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Paris School Road at corner of lands of William F. Gosnell and Mary E. Gosnell, and running thence along line of said lands S. 36-30 W. 728.8 feet to an iron pin in center of road proposed on plat (not opened); thence along center of said road proposed on plat (not opened) N. 39-15 W. 103.05 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 3; thence along line of said Lot No. 3 N. 36-30 E. 708.5 feet to a stake on Southwest side of Paris School Road; thence along the Southwest side of said Paris School Road S. 50-19 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO: All my right, title, and interest of, in and to the proposed road shown on the above mentioned plat of my property which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book R at Page 1, also shown on plat of my property which is recorded in said office in Plat Book B at Page 133 and shown on the plat of property of Steel Heddle Manufacturing Company, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated October 15, 1948.

This is part of the land conveyed to the grantor under her maiden name of Gladys Greene by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated June 20, 1925, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 67 at page 172.
