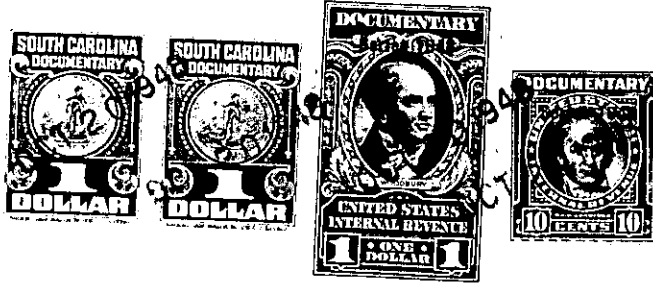

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.H. Thomason and his heirs

and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying about one mile west from the City of Greer, being all of lots Nos. Ninety-nine and One Hundred (99 & 100) on a plat of property made for the W.H. Brockman Estate by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated June, 1926, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 132, situate and being at the intersection of King and Brockman Streets, each lot fronting on King Street seventy (70) feet and running back with uniform distance of one hundred seventy-five (175) feet. Reference to the said plat and record thereof is hereby expressly made for a detailed and complete description of said lots.

R.A. Dobson died testate in the County of Spartanburg, S.C., his will being on file in the Office of the Probate Court of said County. Said will duly authorizes his Executors to convey and sell the real estate owned by the late R.A. Dobson.
