All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of Druid Street, near the City of Green-ville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lots 23 and 24 of Block "E" on plat of Stone Estates, made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, October 1931, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "G" at page 292 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Smith has previously acquired an undivided one-fourth interest in and to said property as one of the four heirs at law and distributees of the late W. C. Smith, Jr., who died in testate October 5, 1940 leaving as his sole heirs and distributees Emily N. Smith, Daniel Baker Smith, H. M. Smith and Ashley Manning Swith. The said H. Maxie Swith died testate February 18, 1948, Buncombe County, N. C. (an exemplified cony of his will being on file in the Probate Court of Greenville County, S. C.)
