(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. John B. Ricketts, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, and being on the east side of TownesStreet in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit;

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Townes Street at a point in the middle of culvert and running thence with a line drawn from the middle of the culvert on Townes Street to the middle of culvert on North Main Street in an easterly direction 205½ feet to an iron pin on the west edge of a 20 foot alley; thence parallel with Townes Street in a southernly direction along the west edge of said alley, 78 feet, to an iron pin; thence in a westerly direction 205½ feet to an iron pin on the east side of Townes Street; thence along the east side of Townes Street in a northerly direction 78 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot is shown on Sheet 3, Block 2, as Lot 2 on City Block Book and it is the intent of the grantors herein to convey to the grantee all of the property owned by them and designated as Sheet 3, Block 2, Lot 2 of the City Block Book above mentioned.

This property was conveyed to our mother, Emma C. Austin, by deed of W. T. Henderson dated November 29, 1912 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 21, page 487. Thereafter the said Emma C. Austin died testate and under her last Will, which is on file in the office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 347, File 3, she devised the above property to the grantors, her only children.

The grantee is to pay 1948 taxes.
