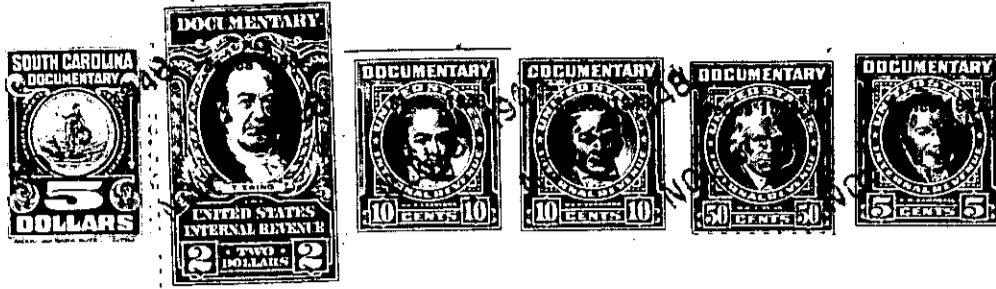

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Trotter Street, in the City
of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds,

Beginning at an iron pin on Trotter Street and running N. 69° 10' 00" E. 100 feet
to a stake; then S. 22° 00' 00" W. 55 feet to a stake; thence S. 69° 00' 00" E. 109 feet to a stake
on Trotter Street; thence along Trotter Street N. 11° 00' 00" E. 55 feet to the beginning
corner.
