 presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. A. Mason, and his Heirs and
Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, lying on the South side of the paved road that
 leads from the Greer-O'Neal Highway, State Highway No. 13, to Ansel
 School House, about two miles Northwest of the City of Greer, and being
 all of Lots Nos. 14, 15 and 24 of the R. B. Mason Estate, according
 to plat thereof made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated August 17th,
 1947, said plat being Plat No. 1, to be hereafter recorded, and
 having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of said Ansel School Road,
 being the joint corner of Lots 13 and 14 on said plat and runs thence
 with the common line of Lots 13 and 14 and also 23 and 24 801 feet to
 a stake on line of E. R. Taylor's lands; thence with E. R. Taylor's
 line N. 62.50 E. 200 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 25; thence
 with the common line of Lots 24 and 25 and also 15 and 16 800 feet to
 a stake on the South side of Ansel School Road; thence with the
 South side of said road S. 63.00 W. 200 feet to the beginning
