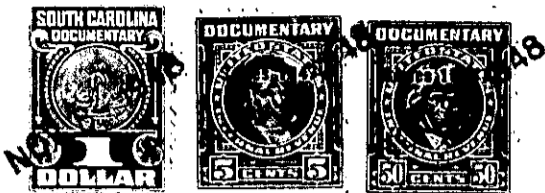

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 114  
on a Map of Lincoln Town, Paris, South Carolina, made by Dalton  
& Neves, June 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "S", page 39, and having, according to said  
Map, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Gandy
