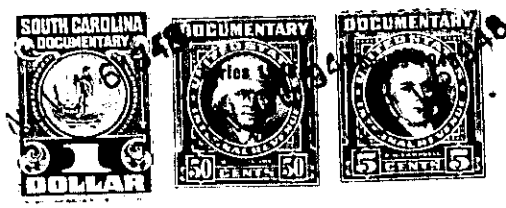

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul G. Hefner, his Heirs and Assigns
forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, about two and one half miles south from Taylors,
lying on west side of the road that leads from Highpoint Grocery to
the Pelham-Greenville Road (also known as the road to the Air Port),
being shown and designated as a part of tract No. 4 on Plat of Prop-
erty of John Walker prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, February
22nd 1947, and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me
by deed from John Walker April 2nd 1947 (not recorded), and having
the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on a stake on the east side of the said road, joint
corner of lots 3 and 4, and runs thence with the dividing line of
lots 3 and 4 and with the line of Boyce Holtzclaw S. 84-45 W. 1043
feet to a stake on the Holtzclaw line; thence a new line S. 2-45 E.
208.6 feet to a stake, new corner; thence N. 84-45 E. 1043 feet to a
stake on the east side of the said road and on the line of Stanly
Vaughn; thence with the said line N. 2-45 W. 208.6 feet to the
beginning corner, and containing Five and No/100 (5.00) acres, more
or less.
