Sirrine and Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, Pages 63, 64 and 65, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Whitney Street at joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15 of Block C, and running thence with line of Lot No. 14, N. 57-30 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 22, N. 0-28 W. 25.55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89-32 E. 137.55 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Whitney Street; thence with west side of Whitney Street, S. 10-50 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with west side of Whitney Street S. 26-52 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee herein agrees to assume and pay the balance due on a certain note and mortgage in the original amount of two thousand dollars heretofore executed by S. A.
