Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.

aforementioned unto the said Eunice R. Bradley and her heirs and assigns forever for the right of burial and for cemetery purposes exclusively, and for no other rights or purposes whatsoever, and subject to the rules and regulations of the said Church now in force, or which may hereafter be passed and adopted relating to the said cemetery and to the burial of the dead therein, upon the following condition which is a part of the consideration for this deed:

That the said property nor any part thereof, nor any right or interest therein shall not be conveyed, leased or otherwise disposed of to any person, or persons, not a member, or numbers, of the said White Oak Baptist Church.

And the Deacons of the said White Oak Baptist Church do hereby bind themselves, and their successors in office (upon the execution of this deed by the Chairman of the said Board of Deacons and the Clerk of said Church) to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Eunice R. Bradley and her heirs and assigns, from and against themselves and their successors in office and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same or any part thereof.
