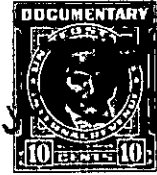

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, H. W. D. Stewart  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred (\$1800.00)  
Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by W. G. Surrine  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. G. Surrine and his heirs and  
assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Trotter Street, and known and design-  
ated as Lot #26 on a plat of the property of J. C. Milford Estate, made by Dalton &  
Neves, Engineers, in 1927, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,  
South Carolina, in Plat Book "H", at Pages 121 and 122, and is the same lot of land  
conveyed to William Norris and Janie Norris by Robert Sullivan on June 20, 1936, deed  
recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 187 at Page 278, and being the same  
tract of land this day conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, in the case of Ella Mae  
Norris, etc. vs. Felix Norris, et al, and described according to said plat as  
follows:

Beginning at an iron pin, as shown on said plat, on the West side of Trotter  
Street and running thence N-70-00-W 150 feet to a point; thence S-13-25-W 50  
feet to a point; thence S-69-36-E 150 feet to Trotter Street; thence with Trotter  
Street 50.6 feet to the beginning corner.
