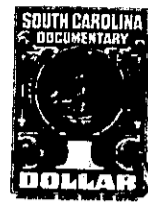

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.B. Dill,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Massena L. Campbell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Massena L. Campbell and his heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Twenty-nine (29) Acres, more or less, on branch waters of Beaverdam Creek, bounded by lands of W.L. Stokes, J.L. Hawkins and others, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning at a stone near the intersection of two branches, the Southwestern corner of said tract, and running thence S. 82 1/2 E. 9.34 chains to stone; thence S. 86 1/2 E. 19.16 chains to a stone; thence N. 27.00 E. 2.00 chains to stone; thence N. 55.00 W. 33.48 chains to a stone; thence S. 7 1/4 W. 18.13 chains to the beginning corner.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by L.J. Stokes on the 28th day of October 1938, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 206 Page 331
