(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rhodes Perdue, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All my undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Aberdeen Avenue in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as all of Lot 17 on Aberdeen Avenue except 5 feet formerly deeded by W. K. Livingston, Trustee, to Amy S. Woodson and also 10 feet off the Southwest part of Lot 16 on plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book F, page 200, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Aberdeen Avenue, said pin being 5 feet Northeast from the joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18, and running thence with Aberdeen Avenue, N. 23-36 E. 70 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot now or formerly of L. Moseley; thence with said Moseley lot, N. 66-24 W. 158 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 25-08 W. 70.03 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 66-24 E. 159 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on Aberdeen Avenue.
