All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying just without the city limits of Greenville in the sub-division known as Eastover and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Maco Street 104 feet from the joint corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30 and running thence with Maco Street S. 36-10 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-50 W. 117.77 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37.01 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-50 E. 118.59 feet to the beginning corner and being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 30 as shown on the above named sub-division, a plat of same recorded in Plat Book "F", Page 42.
