Wesley Burgiss, deceased, at the time of the execution of the wills and codicils thereto, of the said William Wesley Burgiss, dated September 26, 1932, October 27, 1932, May 12, 1937, August 4, 1938, April 4, 1940 and August 7, 1940, referred to in aforesaid agreement, as is shown by record in Judgment Roll E-11,354 on file in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Green-ville County, South Carolina, and wherein it was held and determined that the said William Wesley Burgiss had sufficient mental capacity to execute said will and codicils; and

\*WHEREAS, The parties hereto have reached a settlement and agreement as to the amount which the said Charles H. Gerald should receive as compensation for the time and expenses incurred by him in attempting to prove the mental incapacity of the late William Wesley Burgiss at the time of the making of the wills and codicils hereinabove referred to, and for his services as Atterney in Fact for Shuman Basil Gerald. Jr.,

the said Charles H. Gerald, in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand Five Fundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars, to him in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Shuman Basil Gerald, Jr., does hereby remise, release and forever discharge the said Shuman Basil Gerald, Jr., his heirs and assigns, of and from all claims, demands, suits, causes of action, damages and liabilities of whatsdever hind and nature which the said Charles H. Gerald new has against the said Shuman Basil Gerald, Jr., and especially all claims, demands, suits, sauses of action, damages and liabilities whatsdever which the said Charles H. Gerald has ever had or now has or may have in the future for ecopensation or pagments or interest in any projection, real, personal or wined, under the aforesaid agreement between said parties, dated June 14, 1946.

And the said Charles H. Gerald does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer, set over and release unto the said Chunan Basil Corald, Jr. all his interest in all monies, properties, real, personal or mixed, or interest in the Estate of Million Mosley Burgiss, deceased, acquired by the said Charles
