all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in the 13-F School District, lying on
the South side of the Few's Chapel Road, about one mile North
from Berry's mill, being all of lot No. 1 on a plat of property
made for Henry D. and George D. Forrester by J.Q. Bruce, Surveyor,
dated March 24, 1949, and having the following courses and distances:
BEGINNING on an iron pin just North from said Few's Chapel Road,
on line of W.P. Smith's land, and runs thence with W.P. Smith's line
S. 88.55 W. 1896 feet to an iron pin (old stone corner); thence with
line of Nancy Finley S. 3.00 W. 625 feet, joint corner of tracts
