the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

"All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about 15 miles south of Greenville City, and being about one-half mile off the Augusta Road, on the east side, and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in a public road, at the corner of the land of Robert Arnold and running thence along his line, N. 26.30 E. 261 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Robert Arnold line N. 81.45 E. 392 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 23.15 E. 837 feet to a stone; thence S. 85 W. 315.5 feet to a pin in the center of said road; thence along the road as a line N. 46.10 W. 720 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 8.34 acres, more or less, and being a part of the same conveyed to me by G. W. Stone, dated November 17, 1917, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 43 at Page 253."
