unto the said

The Trustees of Slater-Marietta School District 12-B

"All that certain tract of land near Marietta in the County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, and in Slater-Marietta School
District 12-B, containing 10 acres, and described by metes and bounds
and courses and distances, according to a plat made by Pickell & Pickell
Engineers, on November 17, 1948, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of the Slater-
Marietta Road (formerly known as the Mill Road); which iron pin is 15
feet from the edge of the pavement of said road and 25 feet from the
center of the tracks of the Greenville and Northern Railroad, and
