This agreement shall be binding upon the Greenville News-Piedmont Company and its successors and assigns.

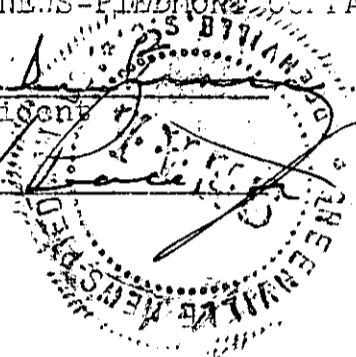

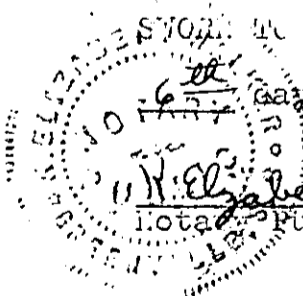
