 leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Norwood Childs, his heirs and assigns, forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, on the White Horse Road, having
 the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northwest side of the White Horse Road, and running thence N. 50 W. 7.43 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 68 W. 20.68 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 32 - 2/3 E. 4.50 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 89 1/4 W. 10.40 chains to a stone O.M.; thence S. 23 1/4 E. 24.50 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 52 1/4 E. 15.15 chains, crossing the White Horse Road, to an iron pin in dry ditch; thence N. 16 W. 3.00 chains to iron pin; thence N. 3 1/2 E. 6.70 chains to an iron pin in the White Horse Road; thence with said White Horse Road N. 68 E. 8.14 chains to a locust tree XOM; thence N. 53 E. 4.80 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands now or formerly owned by S/ B. Cunningham, on the north; H. C. Gilbert on the west; Julius O'shields, on the southwest; Wesley Cantrell on the southeast; and others, containing thirty-five acres, more or less, less the following tracts heretofore conveyed by the grantor:
