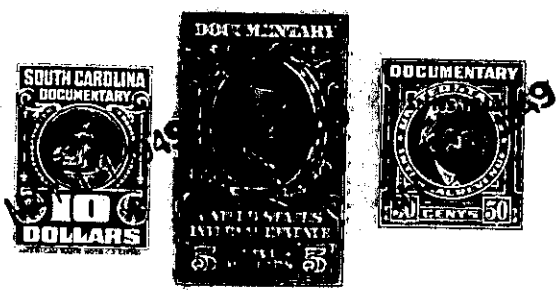

(\$5,000.00) Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by E. P. Castles and Alma M. Castles
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. P. Castles and Alma M. Castles,
their heirs and assigns, forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, containing 3.56 acres, more or less, and having
according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton in September 1945, the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in Poor House Road at corner of property
conveyed to R. C. Hudson and Mary Bridges Mauldin by deed recorded in Vol. 276,
at Page 377, thence along line of said property, S. 76-30 E. 401.7 feet to a
stake on Poor House Branch; thence up Poor House Branch with the meanders of
same, N. 17-0 E. 302 feet to a stake; thence still with said branch, N. 3-03 E.
41 feet to a stake; thence N. 78-40 W. 491 feet to a point on Poor House Road;
thence along said road, S. 0-15 W. 330 feet to the beginning corner.
