KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. W. Barbare and Harold B. Howard in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of four hundred (400) dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Clarence Compton (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Clarence Compton

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances: Beginning at the point in the Highland and Greer road on the corner of Fred Suddeth and Homer Fowler, running thence with said road N. 34.00 E. 120 feet to a bend in said road, thence N. 22.15 E. 266 feet to a point in said road. Thence with a new line N. 87.15 W. 632 feet to a stake, thence, S. 73.00 W 626 feet to a stake, thence S. 81.45 W. 130 feet to a stake in the branch witnessed by a large popular on the north-east side of said branch. This being a corner on the branch of the Homer Fowler line. Thence according to a plat made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, on Nov. 11, 1948 S. 82.25 E. 120 feet to a point on the branch, thence S. 72.16 E. 208 feet to a point on the branch, thence N. 50.52 E. 100.5 feet to a point on the branch, thence N. 84.09 E. 298 feet to a point on the branch, thence N. 88.52 E. 200.5 feet to a stake near branch, thence S. 60.30 E. 334 feet to a point in above said road the beginning corner containing 5.50 Acres, more or less.
