to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by John W. King Jr.  
of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and re-  
leased and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W. King Jr.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being  
in Old Hundred School District, (2 A), in Oaklawn Township, in  
the County of Greenville, State aforesaid. Containing Twenty-  
four and one-half (24½) acres, more or less, and being bounded  
as follows. On the North by lands, now or formerly, of E.L. King  
and J.W.King Jr.; on the East by lands, now or formerly, of Mrs  
Lois Boyce; on the South by lands, now or formerly, of E.Z. Ross;  
on the West by lands, now or formerly, of J. W.King Sr.

The above being the real property left to the grantor herein  
by the will of George W.King, deceased. Said will being duly pro-  
bated in the office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County S.C.  
in June 1936. And being the identical tract of land conveyed to
